

IMPORTANT! Please read all instructions before installing.

Thank you for purchasing a Shakespeare antenna product. Shakespeare works hard to build reliability and durability into all of its products for maximum customer satisfaction.

The 396-1-AIS is a center-fed, 1/2-wave, coaxial sleeve VHF marine antenna of 4' (1.2 m) overall length. It is specifically designed for use with AIS equipment, and meets the strict requirements of the AIS specification. This one-section antenna has an aluminum sleeve for mast mounting.

TOOLS REQUIRED:

⁷/₁₆" wrench

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


Choose a mounting location that is as high as possible, as free as possible from obstructions, and as far as possible away from other antennas and strong sources of RF.

- 1. Mount the antenna to your mast using the supplied 11/4" U-bolts, clamps, lockwashers, washers, and hex nuts, as illustrated in the diagram. The Style 396-1-AIS can be strapped to a larger mast if steel banding (not supplied) is used.
- 2. Connect the antenna to your AIS-enabled equipment with 50-ohm low-loss coax cable with PL-259 connectors on each end (each sold separately). Route the cable as far as possible from other electrical equipment and cables.

This antenna requires no external or internal ground system, and works equally well on fiberglass, wood, or metal boats.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

To clean the antenna, use mild dish washing liquid (one that is not harsh to the hands and without ammonia) in lukewarm water.
